### **Poster Jury:**

It is hoped this will give you greater insight into the process of judging the poster presentations. (In the case that a member of the jury is presenting during a particular poster session, the jury consists of three core members for that session.)

**Prizes** will be awarded for the best talk and the top three posters.

To date, the main **public health** issues to bear in mind for this event are:


