

Information on the cancelled examinations from the winter semester 2019/20:

- **When will the cancelled examinations be rescheduled?**
 - Between 1 June 2020 and 30 June 2020 (if issues occur regarding dates/locations, etc. possibly until mid-July).

- **Do I have to re-register for the cancelled examinations? Is there a registration period?**
 - Students who did not withdraw from the relevant examinations up until the initial exam date are still registered for the exam. There is no new registration period.

- **In view of the SARS-CoV-2 epidemic, I have withdrawn from an exam by way of precaution before the cancellation of examinations was announced. Can I re-register now?**
 - If you have withdrawn from a cancelled exam by way of precaution, please contact the persons responsible for your study programme at the Examinations Office. They will then manually re-register you for the rescheduled examination. Manual registration can be carried out up until one week before the respective examination date. Requests submitted later than that cannot be processed for organisational reasons.

- **I have never been registered for one of the cancelled examinations. Can I still register now?**
 - Students who had not registered for the initial exam date, cannot register now and will not be manually included.

- **How will I be informed of the date, time and location of my examination?**
 - You will receive an e-mail notification from the campus management system if changes are made to the examination details. You can then log in via <https://campus.uni-due.de/cm> using your login data in order to view the new date and time. In addition, the dates will be published on the relevant web pages of the Examinations Office.

- **When will I be informed about the new date and time at the latest?**
 - Two weeks before the relevant examination date at the latest.

- **Where can I find information about my cancelled oral examinations?**
 - Please refer to the schedule on the web pages of the Examinations Office for information on oral examinations. If you have specific enquiries, please contact the responsible chair directly.

- **Which protective measures are in place at UDE regarding written and oral examinations?**

- **Is it possible that the format of an examination changes? If so, how will I be informed about this?**
 - The format of an examination can be changed up until one week before the respective examination date. You will receive an e-mail notification from the campus management system if changes are made to the examination details. You can then log in via <https://campus.uni-due.de/cm> using your login data in order to view the new format.

- **Will attempts at examinations from the winter semester 2020 that have been rescheduled count towards the maximum number of attempts allowed?**
 - If you attend a rescheduled examination from the winter semester 2019/20 in the summer semester 2020 and fail or your mark is 'insufficient', this attempt will be considered as not taken.

- **Do I have to officially withdraw from an examination even though a regulation is in place that failed examinations will not be counted? When is the deadline for withdrawals?**
 - Yes, it is required that you withdraw. The deadline for withdrawals is one week before the examination in question.

- **What happens if I miss an examination without an excuse?**
 - Examination attempts that are marked as 'failed' or 'insufficient' due to absence without an excuse, an examination offence or a breach of regulations are not included in the regulation that failed attempts do not count towards the maximum number of attempts allowed.

Information on the examinations for the summer semester 2020:

- **Will the examinations for the summer semester 2020 be held as usual?**
 - In order to facilitate planning and conducting the examination phase during the SARS-CoV-2 epidemic, examinations will be spread over the entire non-teaching period.

- **When is the registration phase for the examinations of the summer semester 2020?**
 - The registration phase is during the ninth and tenth week of classes in the summer semester, i.e. between 15 June 2020 and 26 June 2020 (please remember: the beginning of classes of the summer semester 2020 was 20 April 2020).
