Workshop description

This two-days workshop addresses a selection of crucial aspects for making a positive impact on stage at a conference, behind a speaker's desk at a symposium or even when reporting research progress to scientific peers during a retreat:

- reaching out to the audience: how to involve and activate the listeners,
- organising, structuring and signposting your content with clarity,
- increasing awareness of our body language: how we are perceived,
- self-confidence and stage fright: controlling unnecessary anxiety,
- voice and articulation: employing a powerful instrument properly.

These notions are woven into a mix of theory, discussions and practical application. During these lively and interactive days, participants are invited to give short presentations themselves and detailed feedback is given.
