CONCEPT OF THE MA CEAS PROGRAM

The Master Program Contemporary East Asian Studies is an English-taught degree program with a social scientific, contemporary and interdisciplinary profile. The program offers research-focused training for highly qualified graduates with BA or similar university degrees in Political Science, International Relations, Sociology, or Economics. The principal focus of the MA program is the theoretical and problem-centred analysis of social, political and economic phenomena in East Asia (PR China, Taiwan, Korea, Japan), and includes intensive training in an East Asian language (Chinese, Japanese, or Korean). Its aim is to deepen and enrich the student's ability to assess contemporary change, the challenges for the East Asian region,
