### List of required documents to be submitted with this application:

The following documents should be submitted, either in English or German. Diplomas, degree certificates, transcript of grades, evidence of language proficiency, etc. need to be scans of the originals or certified copies. If any documents are not already in English or German, you need to submit scans of certified translations.

- Complete and up-to-date CV showing your educational and professional career incl. photo (colour)
- Copy of high school diploma / Zeugnis der Hochschulreife
- Copy of BA degree (incl. transcript of marks, also for semesters abroad)
- Proof of English language proficiency (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, CET, etc.)
- Proof of East Asian language proficiency, if appropriate
- Letter of recommendation by a university professor (to be sent directly to IN-EAST, preferably using the form provided on the IN-EAST homepage)
- Statement on the reasons and your motivation to apply for this program (1-2 pages)
- APS Certificate (= Certificate of the 'Akademische Prüfstelle'): relevant only for graduates from universities in China, Vietnam and Mongolia!

I confirm that all information given is complete and accurate.

For the application for admission to IN-EAST, electronic copies/scans are sufficient. Please note that, in case you are admitted, you may be required to present the original documents or certified true copies (and certified true translations for documents in languages other than English and German) for enrolment at the University of Duisburg-Essen. Be aware that false documents and incorrect statements will result in exclusion from the admission process and the revocation of any offer of admission.
