

## Health Insurance

In order to complete enrolment at the UDE, you have to provide proof of sufficient health insurance coverage.

The International Office is not able to decide if your insurance is sufficient, so please take your policy (or EHIC/AT11) to a local statutory health insurance provider who can either issue you with a certificate proving that you are not required to take out German statutory health insurance or advise you on taking out a suitable German policy. Insurance premium rates for students are currently priced at around €90 a month. If you are older than 30 years, rates increase to at least €160 a month.

You do not have to go to a specific insurance provider, many options are available! Google "Krankenkasse" and you will find several alternatives.
