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Measuring Intercultural Competence and Developing Culturally Inclusive Schools

Abstract

This lecture will present the background and preliminary findings of the ongoing Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions project, INCLUDED. The project has been developed with the aim of contributing to the existing body of research and policy initiatives at a European level, with a specific focus on empowering young people to become active citizens and agents of sustainable change. The project's main objective is to investigate how European school systems can further enhance young people's intercultural competences. It explores potential strategies for effectively integrating these initiatives into large-scale international assessments in education. Of particular interest are assessments such as the IEA's International Civic and Citizenship Education Study, which offer valuable data for educational policy monitoring across multiple European countries. During the lecture, the setup of the project will be addressed, providing insights into its context, objectives, methodologies, and initial findings. The intention is to stimulate a fruitful discussion on this topic, encouraging participants to reflect on the implications for further research, as well as for educational policy and practice.

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
