

Advanced Numerical Methods (CM) Credit Criteria

In order to pass the course, you have to pass the final exam at the end of the semester. Your work on the homework assignments determines whether you are admitted to this exam.

- There will be **two types of homework: Theory and Programming**. Each type will be graded separately. In order to take part in the final exam **you have to obtain 40% of the total homework points in the first and the second part of the semester (in each category, i.e., Theory and Programming)**.
Note: You will only be given points for exercises turned in before the **due date**.
- You have to turn in **every** programming assignment until the end of the semester.
- We will distribute one set of homeworks each week which you have to solve independently.
- Your worked out solutions will be corrected and your independent efforts will be graded.
- You are encouraged to talk with your fellow students about the homework problems. However, if you use parts of a solution or an original idea by one of your fellow students, this must be clearly marked on your written solution.
- The final exam will be a written exam with a duration of 120 minutes. You will not be required to write programs on paper.
