## The Fellowship Program

The Israel Public Policy Institute (IPPI) offers young leaders from Germany an opportunity to participate in a Fellowship program in Israel in cooperation with the Israeli Institute for National Security Studies and the Heinrich Böll Foundation on the theme: "Rethinking Security in the 21st Century: German-Israeli Perspectives".

As part of the program, the Fellows will be required to compose a policy paper pertaining to a security challenge common to both countries; the Fellows will be able to draw on the pool of partners of the IPPI and familiarize themselves with relevant actors in the country.
