A Quick Tour of APA PsycTests

Test Type: Indicates whether a record is an original test, a revision of an existing test, a translation of a test, or a subtest in relation to records listed in the Other Versions field

Search by author, test type, construct, factors, subscales, or year.

Rich records that include **bibliographic descriptors** (e.g., keywords, language, index terms, release date)

Instrument Type: Controlled list indicating the primary testing category

Supporting Documentation includes answer sheets, instructor guides and test manuals, test materials, checklists, and other related materials to provide further background on methodology of test.

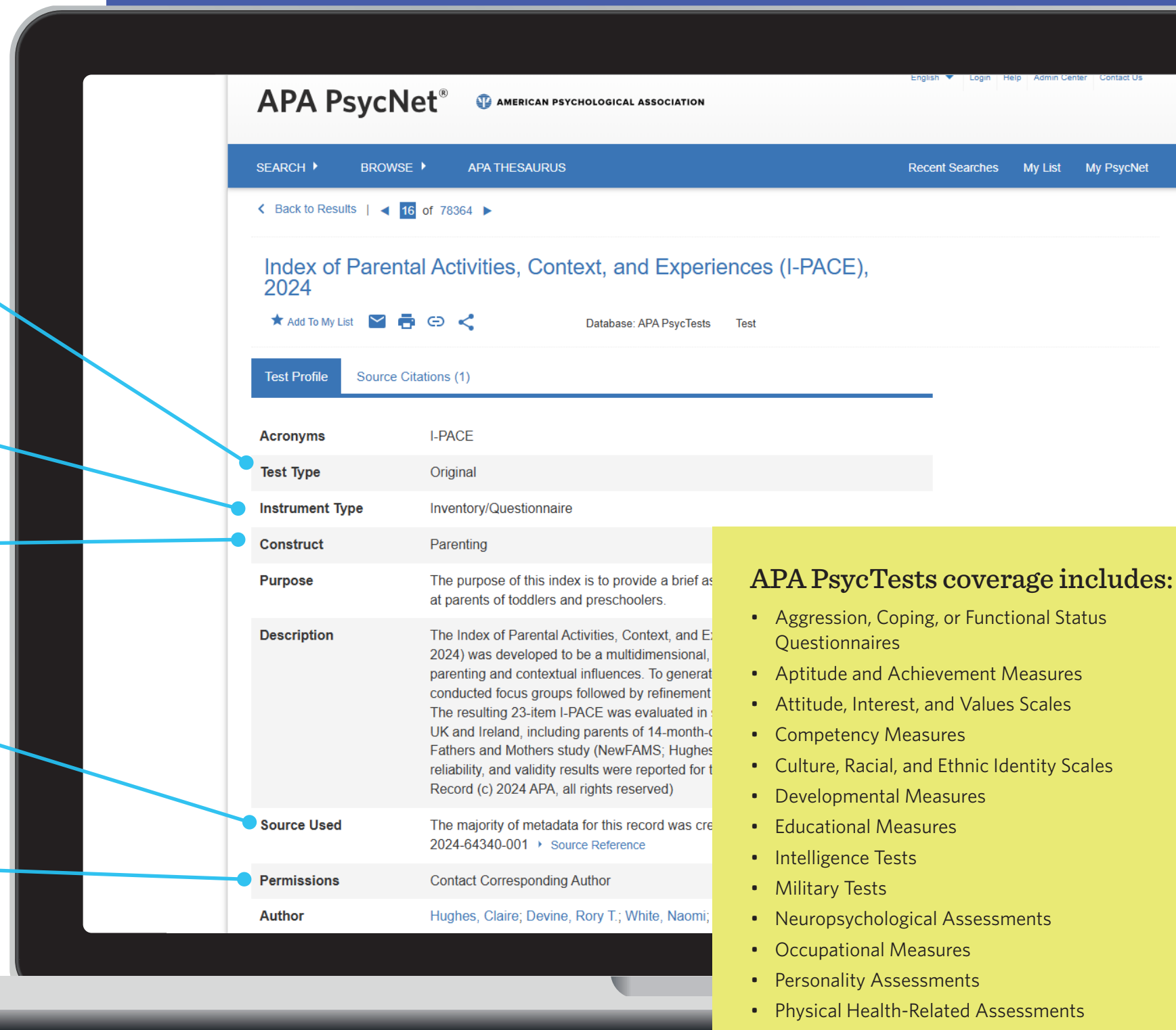
Construct: Psychological construct being measured

Source Citation: Provides a list of the APA Style® citations of APA PsycInfo® and APA PsycExtra® records where the test is used. These citations will be labeled “development”, “review”, or “use”, to indicate how the source used to create the test record relates to the test described in the source

Methodology: Search for records that have used specific psychometric analyses or specific methodologies

Permissions: Answers the question, “Can I use the test for my research?” by identifying permission guidelines for each test

Population/Population Details: Controlled vocabulary that describes the population to which the test was administered
