Would you like to present your work or that of your students? Here you'll find all the information you need about digital exhibitions at the University Library.

Who can exhibit?

- UDE faculty members and researchers, as well as UDE central administrative units

What can be displayed?

- Research findings or student work (e.g., from seminars)
 - Other teaching and research projects
- Do you have other ideas? Contact us!

Requirements for the presentation

- **Format:** Landscape
- **Resolution:** HD (1920 × 1080 pixels)
- **Audio:** not available → add subtitles to videos if necessary
- **Length:** no specific requirement
 - Recommendation: **under 3 minutes**; Reason: The monitors are located in high-traffic areas → Content needs to be easily grasped
- **Copyright:** Note the rights for images and other materials used
- **File format:** a single, continuous file; all common file formats (e.g., ppt or mp4)
- **Context:** In which research project or seminar was the presentation developed?
- **Participants:** List co-authors, participating students, and any other contributors

After the exhibition

- The presentation can be **permanently archived in DuEPublico** upon request
→ if you plan to archive it, select an appropriate CC license
