The Faculty of Chemistry wishes to appoint a  
**W3-Professor for "Organic Chemistry"**  
to commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2014.

The professor is expected to perform research and teaching in organic chemistry and strengthen the research interests of the Institute of Organic and Biomolecular Chemistry. Applicants should have excellent qualifications in the field of organic synthesis focusing on energy conversion. Expertise in organic electrochemistry, photochemistry, synthesis of functionalized organic materials or photoredox catalysis is especially of interest. Participation in the „energy conversion“-related initiatives is expected.

The requirements for an appointment as a professor are specified by §25 of the Niedersächsischen Hochschulgesetzes of February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2007 (Nds. GVBl. 2007 S. 69). The Stiftungsuniversität Göttingen has the right to make this appointment. Further details are available on request. International applicants working abroad are also welcome. Appropriately qualified severely handicapped applicants will be given preference. Göttingen University plans to introduce the professorship into the Program of the federal and local states to enhance the number of female professorships (“Professorinnen-Programm”). Thus, qualified female scientists are expressly encouraged to apply.

The University would like to increase the percentage of women in areas in which they are under-represented and thus encourages suitably qualified women to apply.

Online applications with CV, publications list and details of teaching and research experience should be received not later than April, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014. Printed applications are accepted.
