

Its tasks range from providing networks and servers, e-learning platforms, qualified consulting on all our e-services and on e-learning, media and IT-support, to high-performance computing, training courses, as well as support for special events and processes in the library and in the administration.

The so-called "e-Points" are located in the libraries both in Essen and in Duisburg and function as a competent first level support.

UNIVERSITY USERNAME

The university username is a combination of letters and numbers (if needed) connected to a password, which is required to access most of the services of the ZIM as well as certain restricted services of the UDE. All newly enrolled students of the University of Duisburg-Essen must retrieve the certificate of university identification in HISinOne at <https://campus.uni-due.de/cm> within 4 weeks after enrollment. The username is valid until leaving the university. Subsequently, the given accesses and resources will be removed.

SELF CARE-PORTAL

The selfcare-portal of the user administration makes it possible to change the settings of the username. The password can be changed and a separate WiFi password can be set. Here, the settings for the spam protection of the e-mail account, the memberships for mailing lists of the university (e.g. the newsletter) and the activation of a personal website can be carried out or modified.

Furthermore, information concerning the authorizations of the individual username can be found here. Existing errors can be determined single-handedly, should there be a problem with the authentication. Potential blockings of the username are also shown here.

E-MAIL



Every student of the UDE receives a personal e-mail account on the server `mailbox.uni-duisburg-essen.de`.

The e-mail address is usually generated as follows:

`name.surname@stud.uni-due.de`. It is required for the use of software such as Office 365.

Mails informing about the UDE are also sent to this e-mail address. The e-mail inbox can easily be accessed through the webmail-interface (`webmailer.uni-due.de`). There is no configuration needed.

Additionally, the settings can be adjusted to the individual needs. For example, a forwarding to external or internal e-mail addresses, a personal signature or a notification of absence can be installed.

Every inbox has a certain capacity (Quota). If the Quota is exceeded, new e-mails will not reach the inbox, regardless of the importance.

The ZIM provides the WiFi connection `eduroam`, which is being expanded and upgraded on a regular basis. With the configuration via the CAT tool of the DFN-Association, all necessary settings are made automatically. VPN stands for 'virtual private network'. It enables the establishment of an encrypted connection to IT-services of the university. The access through VPN is required in order to make use of licensed university services such as e-books or certain restricted software.

IT-SECURITY

The security of information is an important topic for students. In order to guarantee a safe usage of computers or smartphones as well as data of the university network, it is important to act responsibly and to abide by certain rules.

Regular updating of the operating system, the use of an up-to-date anti-virus scanner and the use of secure passwords is significant. The ZIM informs about current threats in the RSS feed security.

CERTIFICATES

Every member of the UDE can receive a user certificate which is used for example to entail e-mails with a signature. For the identification, a contact of the ZIM will require a valid ID or a passport.

SECURE PASSWORD

Passwords should at least meet the minimum requirements when it comes to security. Therefore, it should be clear that the personal password ought to consist of a combination of letters, numbers, and symbols a stranger cannot identify, regardless of the type of service it is used for. The use of the same password for multiple services aside from the university (e.g. Facebook or Twitter) does not suffice for a secure login. That is why the ZIM offers a password card that helps generate and administer secure passwords. With a certain scheme that is only known to the owner of the card, an individual password can be read for every needed service.



Sciebo is a cloud storage service for research, study, and teaching, which is run on the servers of the universities in NRW. The data are saved according to the German Data Protection Act.

Students are provided with 30 GB storage capacity.

The data can be accessed on various devices either with an app, a desktop client or the web interface at any time. Individual files or entire folders can be shared with others.




There are free of charge e-learning courses for Microsoft products such as Microsoft Word, Access or OneNote.
