


Bird's eye view: SYSM hospital sits on the bank of the Pearl River, Guangzhou

Dr. Peter Parker (1804~1888)










Canton Hospital in 1859

In 1837, Dr. Peter Parker had recruited three Chinese students, taught them medical theories in English and trained them to be medical doctors.

Dr. John Kerr


- In 1866, Dr.John Kerr opened the Boji Medical Class at Canton Hospital
- Start of systematic training of medical students in China

Where Dr. Sun Yat-sen Studied (1886)





Dr. Sun Yat-Sen, the revolutionary forerunner of China, studied at Boji Medical Class in 1886.
