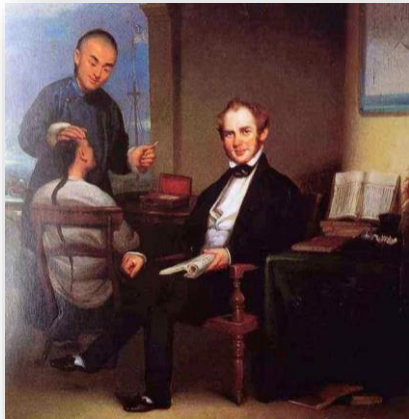

# Origin of Western Medicine in China (1835)



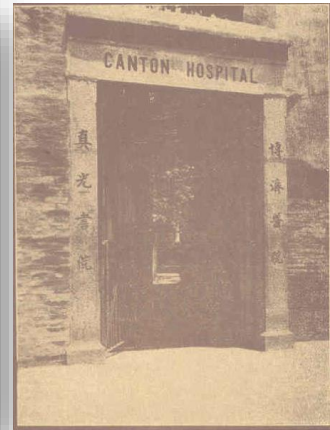
**Hospital Founder:**

Entrance



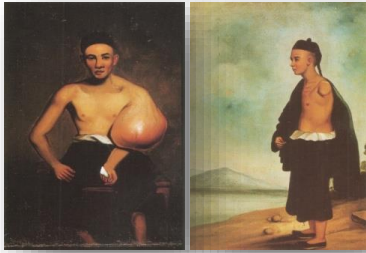
Canton Hospital in 1859

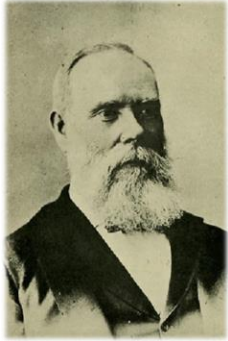

Dr. John Kerr

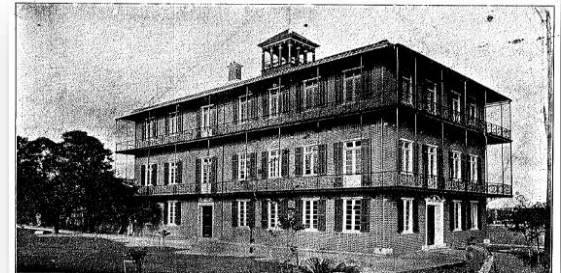
- In 1866, Dr. John Kerr opened the Boji Medical Class at Canton Hospital
- Start of systematic training of medical students in China
