

Health Insurance

In order to complete enrolment at the UDE, you have to provide proof of sufficient health insurance coverage.

You might be able to use a health insurance policy from your home country or take out a private policy but the International Office is not able to decide if your insurance is sufficient so please show your policy documents to a local statutory health insurance provider who can either issue you with a certificate proving that you are not required to take out German statutory health insurance or advise you on taking out a suitable German policy. Insurance premium rates for students are currently priced at around €110 a month. If you are older than 30 years, rates increase substantially.

You do not have to go to a specific health insurance provider, many options are available! Google "Krankenkasse" and you will find several alternatives.
